

PTSA Professionalism Award 2010

Do you know a fellow PTSA member that exemplifies professionalism?

The purpose of the PTSA Professionalism Award is to recognize pharmacy technicians and assistants for their commitment to professionalism through commitment to pharmacy practice.

AWARD DESCRIPTION

PTSA members are invited to nominate a technician or assistant for the award. Self-nominations are welcome. Candidates must be active PTSA members. All nominations should include a completed nomination form and a letter of support. The letter of support should highlight how the member has demonstrated professionalism. A curriculum vitae (CV) or resume may also be submitted. Current PTSA Board Members or Committee Leads are NOT eligible for nominations.

One winner will be selected to receive a \$200 cash award and an engraved plaque which will be presented at the Annual Alberta Pharmacy Technician Conference in September 2010. Attendance at the conference is encouraged but not mandatory or compensated. The winner will also be profiled in the June 2010 issue of Tech Talk, the national newsletter for pharmacy technicians.

Each nomination will be evaluated based on the awards selection criteria. Incomplete nominations or nominations received after the deadline will not qualify for the award.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Professionalism can be displayed in any number of ways including, but not limited to:

- ❑ Promoting the Profession
 - Contributing to enhancing the role of pharmacy technicians and/or assistants
 - Encouraging peers to embrace professionalism
 - Participating in activities that promote pharmacy technical practice

- ❑ Impacting Pharmacy Practice
 - Exemplifying high standards of work performance
 - Contributing to programs that positively impact the delivery of pharmacy services
